

Instructions for Affidavit of Non-Military Status Form

An Affidavit of Non-Military Status is a sworn statement telling the court that the Defendant is not a member of the military service within the meaning of the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act of 2003.

- Complete the top portion of the Affidavit (the “Caption”) the same as on the Summons and Complaint.
- Verify that Paragraphs 1-3 are true and correct.
- You must date and sign the Affidavit of Non-Military Status in front of a Notary Public or Clerk of Courts
- You must file the original Affidavit of Non-Military Status with the Clerk of Courts.
